It is with the utmost regret I am taking this opportunity to submit my resignation as Maintenance Director of Staffordshire Board of Directors effective Aug. 2, 2023.

Although no explanation is required to submit this resignation, I feel it necessary to share my reasons for the decision to resign at this time.

Since day one there has been a group of people who have questioned my ability to hold this position. Although that is something I can deal with, I will not subject myself to the continued dissension, every day harassment by texts and emails questioning this sitting
